

Minutes of Executive Committee Meet, MTS Prayagraj, 11.4.26

Executive Committee meeting of Central Zone IOA was held at Council room, Hotel Kanha Shyam Prayagraj during MTS 2026 on 11.4.26.

President Dr Bhuvan Kumar Singh welcomed the members. No obituaries were observed as per the knowledge of members present.

Minutes of Special GBM and GBM held during CEZCON 2025, Siliguri were read by Dr Peeyush Chansouria and passed by members.

Secretary Report was read by Dr Peeyush Chansouria. He informed the house regarding restart of Fellowship Program from year 2026. Members raised concern for not getting any applicants for Hand Surgery Fellowship under Dr Pankaj Jindal Pune.

He also emphasized to increase the number of members. He urged members to organise academic programmes under the aegis of Central Zone IOA. In the absence of Treasurer and Joint Secretary Headquarter, the financial report was read by Dr Bhuvan Kumar Singh. He told that from 1.9.25 to 31.3.26 total income of association was 377000 Rupees (27000 LM Fees of 9 new members + 250000 CEZCON Agra 2024 + 100000 MTS Jaipur). Total Expenditure in above period was 169635 Rupees (12000 Dr Pradip Chaudhary Past Secretary, 30000 towards two Ganga Fellowships, 45088 Dr Sanjay Dhawan Past President, 17547 TDS, 5600 Salary of Mr Udai, Patna office staff from July 2024 to February 2026). The total assets of Central Zone IOA amounts to Rs 5478331.20 till 31.3.26.

Dr Bhuvan informed that audited report of account has been uploaded on Bihar Govt Portal for society registration. Regarding payment of CA members authorized Dr Bhuvan to negotiate and to pay him 150000 including GST and to take care to deduct the TDS before payment. House also requested him to discuss and get the work completed regarding legal aspects of finances such as DARPAN Registration, GST Registration, Form 12A filing, TAN number Registration. He was also entrusted with the task of getting signatories changed in the Bank Account.

Editor report was read by Dr C P Pal, Editor. JOTR. He informed that Journal is indexed with DOAJ and Indian Science Abstracts and 3 issues per year will be printed henceforth. He invited papers from members.

He also informed the house regarding debts of Journal which includes Rs 322166.21 outstanding payment to Wolter Kluwer and a further need of approx Rs 3 Lakhs for upcoming issue of April 2026. However he assured the house to get some income from advertisement and Royalty in future in order to cut short the expenditure of association.

As Dr Alok Agrawal, Raipur could not come to Prayagraj due to sad demise of his mother, it was decided to hold an online EC meeting on Zoom Platform to discuss the progress report of CEZCON 2026 and update on electoral process for Annual Election of association, within 10 to 15 days. However, members raised concern regarding Registration Tariffs for CEZCON 2026. It was proposed by Dr S C Goel Sir to follow the constitution of IOA which says that a maximum hike of 10 percent is allowed in subsequent conferences for registration. Dr Amulya K Singh proposed to consider to lower down at least the Non Residential Registration charges. It was also decided to discuss the proposals of YOUNG SURGEON FORUM in next Zoom meeting.

Dr Jayant Sen, Chairman Fellowship Committee told that we have started the process all in black and white following guidelines and criteria for selection and the purpose of interview is just to ensure that appropriate person will represent the Central Zone IOA. Request of webmaster Mr R K Singh to increase his charges was raised by Dr Peeyush Chansouria and members directed President Dr Bhuvan Kumar Singh and Secretary Dr Peeyush Chansouria to negotiate for a fair deal.

Meeting ended with vote of thanks from Dr Peeyush Chansouria.

MINUTES OF GENERAL BODY MEETING, 20th SEPTEMBER 2025.

President Dr Sanjay Dhawan was in Chair and he welcomed all members present in Main Hall of Aurum by RJ Resorts, Siliguri on 20.9.25 during CEZCON 2025. As per the agenda meeting started by paying homage to deceased members :

Secretary Report was read by Dr Peeyush Chansouria and passed by GBM.

Dr Bhuvan Singh presented the audited treasurer report. Total assets of Central Zone amounts to 44 lakh 49 thousand 950 Rupees and 20 Paise.

He informed that CA fees for audit is amounting to 150000. Minutes of Executive Committee meet during CEZCON 2025, Siliguri were also presented and passed. Decision of EC to nominate Dr Navin Kumar Singh as Treasurer was also approved by GBM.

Election report 2025-26 was presented by Dr. Bhuvan K Singh. Following candidates were declared elected unopposed : Dr Alok C Agrawal President Elect.

Dr K D Tripathi, Vice President Dr Vishal Shekhawat, State Representative Rajasthan Nominaton by Executive Committee of Dr Vipin Jain for state representative Chhattarh was also approved by GBM.

Fellowship Committee Report elaborating guidelines and criteria was presented by Chairman Dr Jayant Sen and passed by GBM.

Dr Arun Kapoor, Organizing Chairman CEZCON2024, Agra presented a check of 2.5 lakhs in favour of Central Zone IOA and 2 lakhs to Account of JOTR. Organizing committee CEZCON 2024 Agra have already paid Rs 4 lakhs to Central Zone, making it to a total of 8.5 lakhs. Members appreciated their efforts.

Dr Bhuvan informed the house that 292 delegates and 52 PGs got registered for CEZCON 2025 with participation of 700 Pharmaceutical companies and 40 stalls.

He promised to give Rs 2 lakhs to association instantly and more once account is audited.

Dr Sanjay Dhawan proposed to pass the amendments in Constitution presented in Special GBM. After discussion, GBM approved and ratified the Constitutional amendments for incorporation in the constitution of Central Zone IOA.

List of new members (12) was also approved by GBM.

Dr Atul Srivastava proposed and requested all members to increase membership number.

Two Committees were formed for a term of 2 years with approval of GBM:

1. Fellowship Committee : Chairman Dr Jayant Sen Members - President, Secretary and Editor

2. Young Surgeon Forum : Chairman Dr Santosh Singh Members- Dr Ramit Ranjan Bihar Dr Arun Sharma Rajasthan Dr Vivek Kumar Kori MP Dr Vipin Jain, Chhattisgarh.

Dr Bhuvan Kumar Singh announced the winners of medal sessions which were as follows:

A small presentation for CEZCON 2026 at Raipur was given by Dr Alok C Agrawal and by Dr K D Tripathi for MTS 2026 at Prayagraj. They invited members for their respective events.

Dr Sanjay Dhawan and Prof S C Goel requested President and Secretary of member state associations to reciprocate and invite their counterparts in Central Zone IOA to state conferences.

Dr Piyush Mishra, President UPOA invited members to UPCON Agra.

On request of Office staff Mr Udai, approved his salary hike from 2000 per month to 5000 per month.

Minutes of Special General Body Meeting

Minutes of Special GBM held on 20th September 2025 in Main Hall of Aurum, by R. J. Resorts, Siliguri during CEZCON 2025. Meeting was called to order by Dr. Sanjay, Dhawan President Central Zone IOA.

Members were requested to assemble in the main hall. President welcomed all members and explained that the purpose of Special GBM was to discuss and ratify proposed constitution amendments. Secretary Dr. Peeyush Chansouria invited Prof. S C Goel, Chairman of the Constitutional Amendment Committee to present the proposals.

Dr. Goel Sir informed the house that online suggestions were invited from the members, proposals were presented and discussed at EC meetings during MTS Jaipur and then during present CEZCON 2025.

The amended constitution was presented with deletions (strike through red) and insertions (sky blue) clearly marked for member review.

Following proposals were presented :

1. Name of Jharkhand as member state was removed as they have opted out and joined East Zone. Life members from Jharkhand will continue to be the members of Central zone, but without any voting rights. They will not be considered for any award or post as other members residing outside Central Zone member states.
2. Life member and associate member rights and privileges, can be reviewed and amended by EC and GBM from time to time and will not need constitutional amendment in Special GBM .
3. Allied subject word for eligibility was removed.
4. GBM was authorized to take final decision for termination of members .
5. Official bank account of Central zone will be operated by Treasurer and Joint Secretary, Headquarter. Written permission from Secretary on Email will be necessary for any transaction.
6. Mode of payment for membership fees should be online and office was directed to obtain a QR code for the account.
7. Life membership fees was raised to 3000 from earlier 2000.
8. Associate member fees will be 500 and on paying 2500 later after attaining the required qualification /eligibility, Associate member can become a life member.
9. Annual conference will be of three days duration. Conference will be allocated to state to which the president-elect belongs .

10. MOU between organizing secretary and association will be mandatory.
11. Valedictory function and change of Collar will be done during the banquet.
12. Scientific Committee for conference will comprise President Elect, Immediate Past President, President and Secretary.
13. Minimum of seventy five percent lectures will be allotted to members working in jurisdiction of central zone states.
14. Session on basic Science and Oncology will be included in Annual Conference.
15. Past presidents and life members above 65 years of age will be exempted from conference registration.
16. President and Secretary of IOA , if present shall be seated on dais.
17. Certificates will be signed by President and Secretary of Central Zone , Organizing Chairman and Organizing Secretary.
18. Young surgeon forum will be found for members less than forty years of age.
19. Memento presentation will not be done on dais , but at a separate place to avoid wastage of time.
20. Audited account of Conference shall be presented before next EC and next business meeting (GBM).
21. MTS will be allotted to the state to which the President Elect belongs. MOU will be signed as for Annual Conference.
22. Ten percent of total collection or fifty percent of savings , whichever is more shall go to central zone.
23. Speakers for Orations shall be finalized during MTS.
24. For Ghaziabad, lecture applications should be submitted in the format of JOTR. Secretary will notify six months before annual conference.
25. All Orations and Ghaziabad Lecture will be delivered by members living in central zone , except for Dr B N Sinha Oration.
26. For Lifetime Achievement Award, member should have more than twenty years of experience.
27. Editor of JOTR will be nominated by EC for a term of 2 years which can be extended for one more term .
28. Members of editorial board will be nominated by EC on advice of editor.
29. There will be 1 Editor and 10 members in Editorial Board.
30. Newsletter will be published only on website.
31. There will be 2 state representatives from each state , making it to a total of 10 members.

32. President and Secretary of member states will be Ex Officio members of EC and they will be expected to be members of central zone.
33. Outgoing Secretary of Central Zone will be member of Executive Committee for 1 year.
34. To be eligible for contesting election the member should have served at least one term of 2 years as EC member and should have attended at least 5 Annual Conferences of Central Zone.
35. Nomination fees for contesting election was raised. For President it was fixed to Rupees Five Thousand and for Vice President and Secretary Rupees Two Thousand.
36. Treasurer and joint secretaries will be nominated by Executive Council.
37. In absence of Secretary, the senior most Joint Secretary as per the membership number will officiate in next elections.
38. Constitution of IOA will be followed if the member is not included in Central Zone Constitution.

Above amendments were proposed by Prof S C Goel Sir and seconded by Dr. RC Meena, Dr. Amulya K Singh, Prof. Amit Rastogi and Dr. Santosh Singh. Special general body meeting concluded with note of thanks to all and Constitution Amendment Committee from Dr. Sanjay Dhawan, President Central Zone IOA
